

# Persuasive essay conclusion example

Violence was not created by television. The links between television and juvenile violence is clear, but we must beware of drawing false conclusions from this correlation. If television is permitted to be the sole influence on a child and if there is no context within which the child views television, the consequences can be damaging and indeed grotesque. The television does not, however, corrupt the child unaided; that process begins earlier and is instigated by the forces that make television the child's guardian and moral arbiter -- roles for which it is completely unsuited. Clearly, television does not seek to be a universal nanny; relatively little thought and money is applied to children's programming. That it becomes one is a tragic and dangerous outcome, but one for which television itself is not to blame.
